

## **DA7C DOWNHILL RACING RULES**

### **All Cars**

1. Each car must be able to fit into a shoe box 12" inches long, 6.5 inches wide and 4.75 inches high (304mm x 165mm x 120mm). The cars must be able to fit in the scrutineer's "garage" on the night.
2. Cars must not be heavier than 6ozs (170g).
3. Cars may be made from any material including metal, wood, card, plastic, adhesive tape and glue. The car must be made by the owner out of bits and pieces. The vehicle does not have to look like a traditional car.
4. Only one car per entrant accepted.
5. The car that travels the greatest distance down the track, between the tapes, shall be the winner. There are two classes – The Downhill Challenge Trophy (for men) and The Ladies' Cup. There will also be a "Concours" prize for the car judged the best-looking or best engineered model on the night.
6. There shall be no powered starts or runs, only free running from the top of the ramp and along the track.
7. Depending on the number of entries there may be several runs and, in which case, the longest run will count.
8. Signing-on to start at 19.00 and close at 20.00.
